Our Core Values:

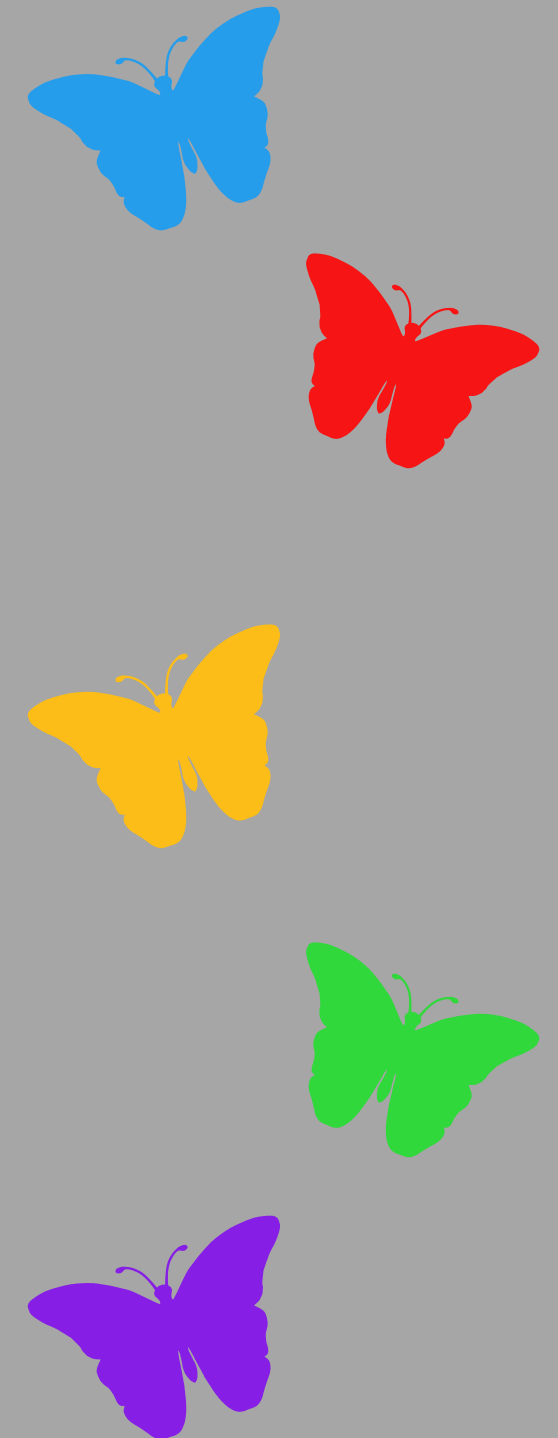

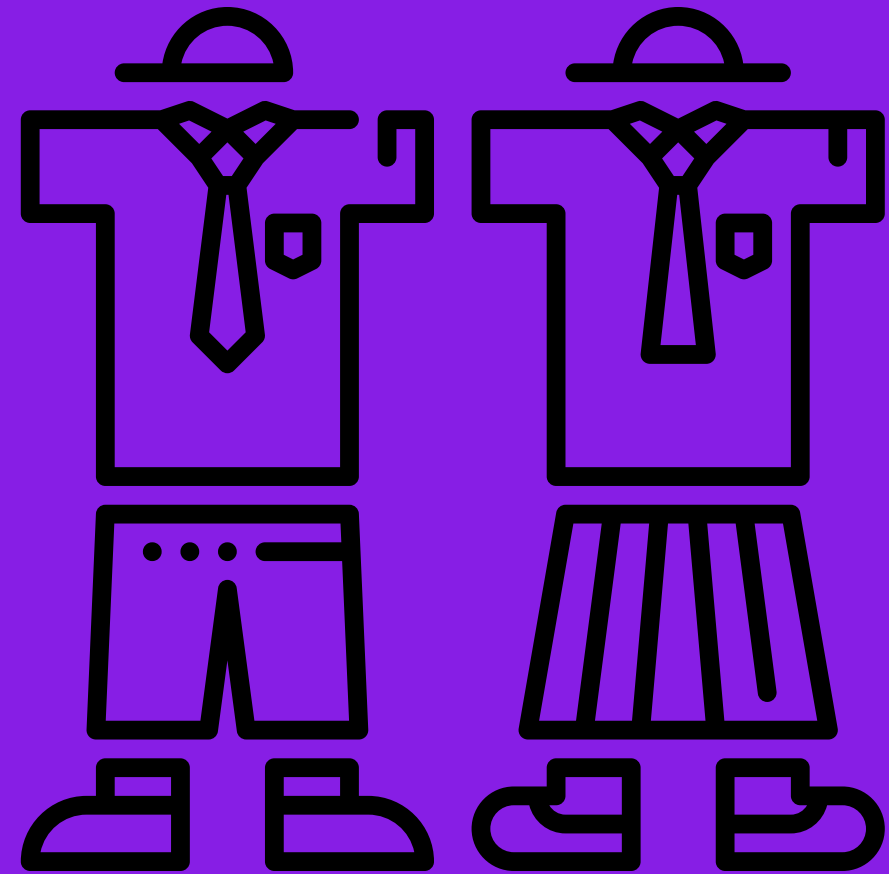

Morning break: 10.30-10.45am

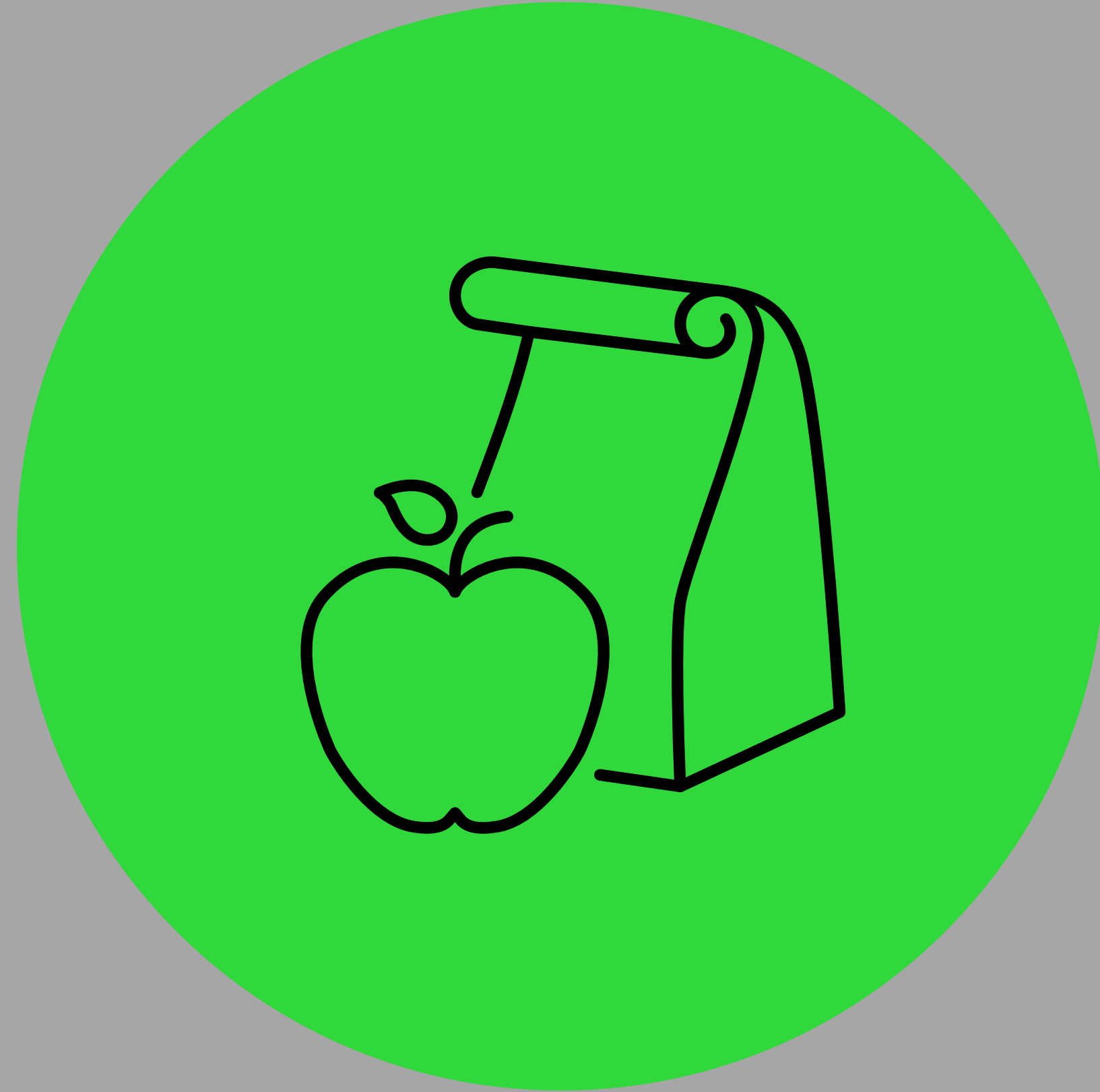
Lunch time: 12.15-1.00pm

LUNCH OPTIONS



HC3S provide a daily lunch option for hot meals as they have done in the infant school. Meals are prepared on site and children currently have two options to choose from during registration.

The current cost of a school meal is £3.00

A **healthy**_packed lunch is also an option to bring in from home.

FREE SCHOOL MEALS



Please ensure you are signed up for these. It gives the school more funding to support your child which we use in a number of ways including reduced trip and residential fees. The form can be accessed using the QR code or via this address:

You just need one of the following:

- Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods)
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit) and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit

SCHOOL COMMUNICATION

The school uses an app called Marvellous Me to relay all of our positive rewards. It is really important that you sign up for this. The app is free and it is a one way traffic system from us to you - no need to respond unless you want to give a thumbs up back.

HOMework



We are a reading school. Children are expected to read 5 times a week at home and record this in their reading diary.

Spelling activities are sent home once a week linked to our Scode spelling scheme.

It is important the children learn their multiplication tables. We therefore ask the children to complete a Times Table Frenzy once a week.

ENTRY AND EXIT POINTS



The children will be able to enter and exit their class from the back of the school.

The children will be shown their entry door on the transition day.

On the first day of school in September your child's class teacher will come out on to the playground to remind the children where they can come in.

At the end of the day, the children will also leave through these doors.

BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL CLUB



From September 2024 an external company will be running a before and after school provision for wrap around care. This is new to the school and will work across both school sites. Further details will follow this term.

HOUSE TEAM SYSTEM

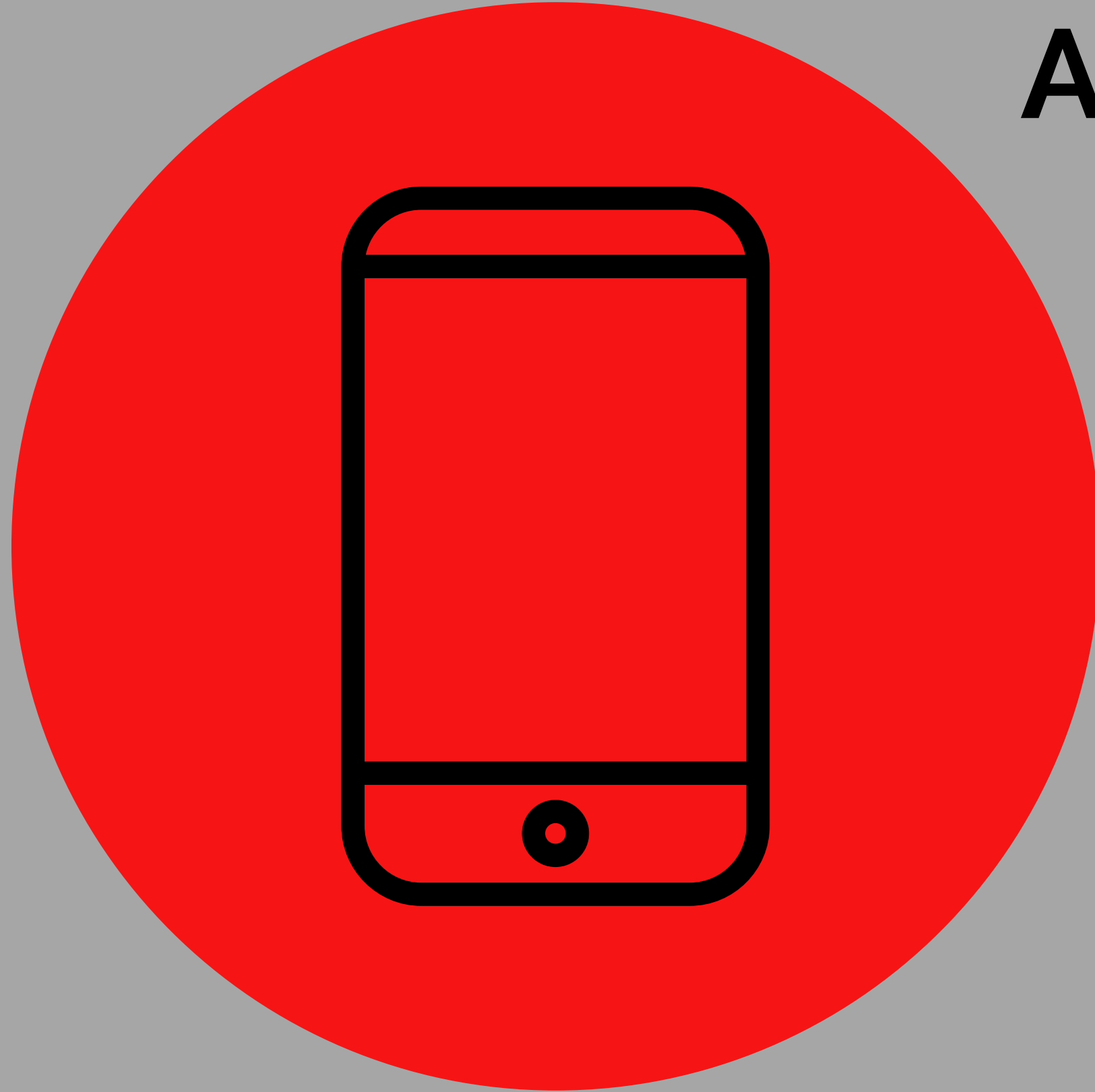


There are 5 house teams within our school which link to the colours that represent each of our core values. Your child will be assigned to one of the following houses:
