We currently have an exciting opportunity for a parent/guardian to join us as a Parent Governor on the board of Hart Plain Junior School.

The governing body's main tasks are:

- to oversee the financial performance of the school, making sure its money is well spent.

Parent governors are valued members of the team and play a vital role in ensuring that the governing body has access to parent perspectives and a greater knowledge of the local community.

We feel sure that there are parents prepared to take on this important role and to give their time and commitment to helping us to continue to improve the school's

performance, also, to play their part in ensuring that our pupils fulfil their aspirations.

Full training and support will be available to help you develop into the role. This will include in-house mentoring and support, as well as access to external governor training.
