## **Hart Plain Junior School – Breakfast Club**

Following further feedback from parents, we have taken on board concerns around the changes to the timings of the club. We shall now be offering a staggered Breakfast Club option. The two options now available to the children will be:

Option 1 = 7.30-8.30am – Childcare and breakfast available - £3.50

Option 2 = 7.55-8.30am – Childcare only - £1.50

Food service will cease at 7.55am.

Parents (or an older sibling of at least secondary school age) will need to sign the children in each morning to Breakfast Club.

Registration forms must be completed for the children and all payments must be made online using Tucasi and no cash payments will be accepted by the club. Your logon information can be provided by the office. These forms will be available from Breakfast Club and the office from the middle of next week.

This change will take place immediately after the Christmas break, i.e. Monday 7<sup>th</sup> January 2019.

## **Year 6 visit to the D-Day Museum and the Royal Garrison Church, Southsea Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> January 2019**

In order to support our learning about World War 2, we have organised a trip to the D-Day Museum and the Royal Garrison Church, Southsea, on Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> January 2019.

We will leave school, travelling by coach, at 9.15am. All children will need a packed lunch on this day, preferably packed in a disposable carrier bag so it can be thrown away. If your child requires a free school meal, please tick the appropriate box in the permission slip. We will return to school at approximately 3.00pm. Children **MUST** wear school uniform and have a coat. However, they can wear alternative, more comfortable footwear if they choose.

The total cost of this visit is **£8.45**. We appreciate this is a financially demanding time of year which is why we have tried to inform you of this visit well in advance. However, in line with the Governors' Policy on charges for school visits, we are obliged to inform you that parents cannot be required to make such a contribution, and that if they do not their child cannot be excluded from this activity. However, if a significant number of parents are either unable or unwilling to contribute towards the cost of this visit, then either this, or subsequent visits for **this** year group may not be able to take place.

During the day, we will also have the opportunity to visit the shop. If you wish, your child may bring in a small amount of pocket money to spend at the shop. The maximum amount of money each child can bring is £2.50 and it must be kept in a labelled purse or wallet.

We are looking for four parent helpers on the day. Please indicate if you are able to come by ticking the appropriate box on the attached reply slip.
