### Year 5 Virtual Session with Hampshire Fire and Rescue

On Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> March, the children in Year 5 joined a live virtual session with Hampshire Fire and Rescue Schools Education Team.

Lillian Steel in Darwin sent us this report:

*The visit from the fire services was a bit weird and strange because it was virtual, but I learned so much. I learned how a fire could start and how long it takes to spread across a room. I also learned what to do if my clothes were on fire. They told me to stop, drop and roll, because it's not giving oxygen to the fire and that is one of the things that makes it spread more quickly. We were also told to make sure we don't overload plug sockets or put phones and iPads on charge on our beds.*


