See Nature

We were very excited to watch our eggs hatch over last weekend and hope you were able to witness this too! Our blue tit and chicks seem to be doing very well, and mum and dad have been in and out of the box all day.

The blue tit chicks will spend around three weeks in the nest before fledging. During that time, they will more than quadruple in size, developing feathers and the wing muscles they will need for survival outside the nest.

Feeding the chicks is a full time job for both parents. Each baby can demand 100 caterpillars per day and produce plenty of poo as a result. To keep things clean and tidy, the parents remove the white faecal sacs each chick presents them with and dispose of them away from the nest.

As fledging approaches, the chicks exercise their wing muscles by flapping them rapidly. They then begin to explore the entrance to the nest, eventually taking that first leap of faith into the world beyond!
