Positive Points

- You can play the game in a single player mode, and enjoy progressing through the game upgrading your car.
 The settings within the game have been kept minimalist to keep the experience of the game the same
- for everyone.

NEGATIVE POINTS

- 1. Going online, sometimes the user experience can be spoilt by those only looking to ruin your race and this can cause frustration.
- 2. The reporting features appear to be extremely basic with no real reviews on how effective it is.
- 3. The rise in available content has seen younger children go on to 'older' content much sooner than previous generations, sometimes negatively impacting their behaviour.
