Dear Parents and Carers,

Now COVID-19 restrictions have been lifted, we will be holding a disco for the children on Wednesday 19th October 2022. This disco will be run by a professional DJ!

Years 3 and 4 are invited to attend from 5.45pm until 6.30pm with tickets priced at £2.00. Years 5 and 6 are invited between 6.30pm and 7.30pm with tickets priced at £2.50. Tickets will be issued to the children in school once their permission form has been returned and payment has been made on ScoPay. **We regret that we will not be able to sell tickets on the evening because of strict fire regulations regarding numbers.**

Please note that refreshments are included in the price of the ticket so your child does not have to bring any money to the disco. No chewing gum is allowed in school during this event. For safety and security reasons children should not bring mobile phones to the disco.

Please ensure footwear is appropriate. Heels should be no higher than 6cm with a broad square heel of at least 3 x 3 cm. Please avoid sharp edges to the heels as these deeply gouge the hall floor.

At the start, please drop your child at the FRONT of the school via the reception door where a register will be taken. However, when you collect your child, please collect them from the BACK playground. We will dismiss the children once their adult is visible to school staff. Children are not permitted to walk home alone. If another adult is collecting your child on your behalf, please let Miss Jones know when you drop them off.

Children who are not well enough to go to school that day will not be considered fit enough to go to a disco that evening. It is also assumed their behaviour in school has been appropriate preceding the event.

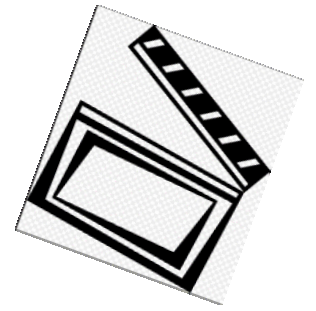
