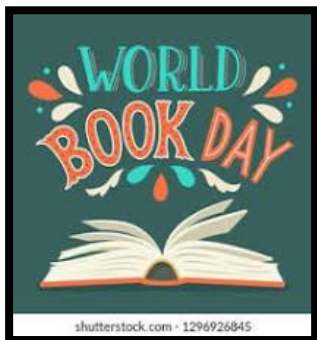

Head Lice

Cases of head lice have been reported this week. Please could we all take extra care with checking children's hair.

Although the lice can be seen in dry hair, the best way to check is by the coming of wet hair with a fine-toothed detector comb.

If lice are found, it is important to check and, if necessary, treat the rest of the household. Regular wet-combing as part of routine hair washing is the best way to prevent the problem recurring.
