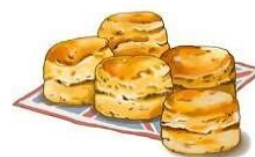

Stubbington Study Centre Day Camps 2024

Stubbington Study Centre is offering children in years 3 – 6 (during academic year 2023/24) the opportunity to take part in our Summer Day Camps. Day Camp activities are planned and delivered by qualified teachers and experienced outdoor educators. These activities will take place within the Centre's secure 14-acre site that has been welcoming Primary school aged children here for over 80 years.



We will be offering two weeks of Day Camps, Monday 29th July to Friday 2nd August and Monday 5th to Friday 9th August, from 8.45am to 4.30pm. Each day of each week will have a different theme; giving children the chance take part in a wide variety of activities. You can sign your child up for individual days, or for whole weeks.

This year, we are also offering the opportunity to sign up for an early drop-off and breakfast at an additional charge of £5 a day. Our early drop-off time will be 8am and breakfast will include cereal and cooked options.

Our day camps are priced at £32 per day, £150 to book a whole week. This price includes a sandwich lunch with refreshments and snacks during breaks.
