

Experiences

This term, the children will be exploring Early Man through drama and visiting Butser Ancient Farm to explore everyday life in the Stone Age. Zoo-lab will be visiting to help the children understand how bodies move.



Computing

In computing, the children will be learning how to touch type. The focus will be how to type with both hands, understanding how to sit at the keyboard and how to use home, top and bottom row keys.

Physical Education



In P.E, both classes will be studying hockey where they will learn how to pass and receive the ball, move with the ball, how to get past an opponent alongside tackling and scoring.

English

In English, we will be writing our own set of instructions on how to wash a woolly mammoth. The children will be reading the Stone Age Tales to understand life in Stone Age times.



Personal Development

This half term, the children will be learning about families, what makes a family and how it can look different for different people. They will be exploring diversity and equality through story books and discussions.



Religious Education

In R.E we will be studying the symbol of a tree and what it represents in both Christianity and in Judaism. They will then make comparisons between the two religions, to deepen their understanding.

Autumn 1

Maths

In maths, we will be recapping our number bond knowledge from Year 2, building on this by adding together 3 numbers and representing this in different ways. We will then be learning to do the same thing with numbers up to 1000!



Art

This half term, children will be learning about the primary colours and will be experimenting mixing them to create secondary colours. They will explore cave paintings from the Stone age, before recreating their own!



History

The children will be looking at the Stone Age and Bronze Age and deciding which period they would prefer to live in.
