Religious Education

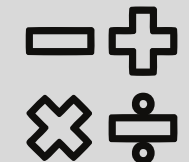

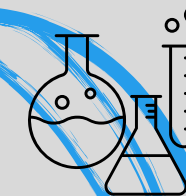
History
