Computing

Spring 2

Maths

In maths, the children will be learning how to use partitioning strategies to subtract and add. They will also focus on bridging, finding the difference and understanding mental strategies to support these skills.



D&T

This half term, children will be designing, making and evaluating a savoury snack. They will understand the importance of nutrition and the different food groups.



History
