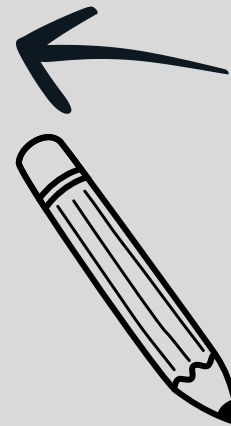
Personal Development

In PDL, we will be learning about Mental Health and Well-Being. Children will explore fixed and growth mindsets, making links to how we meet our 5 'C' needs.

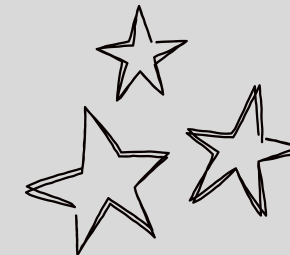


Religious Education

Maths
