## Computing

In Computing, the children will be using powerpoint to create their own presentation. They will learn how to add slides, text, change fonts, create transitions and add timings, before presenting to the class.

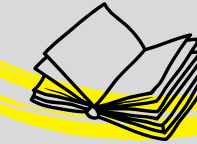
## Physical Education

## Personal Development

In PDL, the children will look at how we keep our bodies clean, what body parts we have, who are our trusted adults and what we love about our bodies.



## Religious Education

In RE, the children will continue exploring the concept of rituals, looking at Christianity and Judaism and will debate whether rituals should be abolished!



# Y3 Curriculum Overview

## Summer 2

## Maths

In maths, the children will continue to enhance their knowledge on non-unit and unit fractions and will be further developing their understanding of column addition and subtraction.



## Art

This half term, children will be sketching, working with watercolours and using different texture to create images of rivers. They will then do their final piece, where they will learn about weaving.



## Geography

This term, the children will be learning about rivers. They will learn about human and physical features, the location of rivers in the UK, how to use atlases and comparing different rivers and their features.



## Science

This term, the children will be learning about light. They will understand the language: transparent, opaque, translucent and reflective. They will learn that light comes from a source and that we need light to see things.



## French

In French, the children are learning how to say types of vegetables. Then, they are going to learn how to ask for fruits in a shop or at a market stall. We will then act out market stalls in groups!
