Computing

In computing, this half term children will be exploring micro:bits! They will be able to understand that a micro:bit is a tiny computer which needs code to make it work. The children will be creating this code to input into the micro:bit, so that it can display different outputs.

Physical Education

This half term in PE, Year 5 will be developing the skills to play cricket. Both classes will also be learning about athletics with our Sports Coach.

English

This half term we are focusing on the book 'Windrush Child' by Benjamin Zephaniah. The outcome of this unit is to write a diary entry from the perspective of the main character. The children will be learning about the Windrush and what impact it had on people at the time.

Personal Development

In PDL, we will be exploring safe and unsafe touch, specifically thinking about how we can keep ourselves safe. We will also look at body image. Further into the unit, we will look at puberty, periods and conception.



Religious Education

This half term, we will complete two R.E units. Both of these units are linked to the Islamic faith with a particular focus on sacred places and a sense of community. Last term we had a visit from an Imam who has given us lots of information to draw upon in the upcoming units of work.

Summer 2

Maths

In Maths this half term we will be continuing to work with Fractions - specifically, looking at equivalent fractions. Then, to end Year 5 we will be looking at angles where Mx. Colley has planned an art activity linked to this!



DT

For DT, in Summer 2, we will be sewing! We will start our unit by looking at existing products of tablet cases. Then we will practice a variety of stitches before designing and making our very own tablet cases.



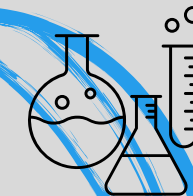
Geography

Science
