Computing

In computing, we will be coding with micro:bits. Children will use these to create lots of mini projects. Within Online Safety, children will be paying particular attention to WhatsApp and discussing ways in which they can stay safe and be respectful on this platform if it is a chosen method of communication.

Physical Education



In P.E, we will be learning about different athletic events including: sprinting, long-distance running, triple jump and standing long jump. With the coach, children will be exploring volleyball and the rules regarding this sport.

English

We will be exploring the text: Wolf-Brother. Children will be showcasing various Key Stage 2 writing skills into an outcome and sharing this with their class. Children will write an internal monologue as well as use dialogue to advance the action in a 'fight-scene'.



Personal Development

In PDL, children will be learning about puberty and their bodies. They will also learn about conception with a focus on consensual and respectful relationships.



Religious Education



In R.E this half term will be exploring the concept of peace within the Islamic faith. We will be thinking about what peace means to us and what this may look like visually. Children will be encouraged to make links to the information gathered from the Imam's visit.

In DT, we will be building on our knowledge of circuits by creating an alarm. Children will think carefully about what materials will be needed, how they are going to assemble this and evaluate the success of their alarms.

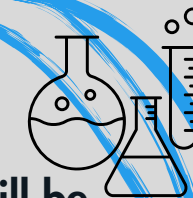


Geography

Science



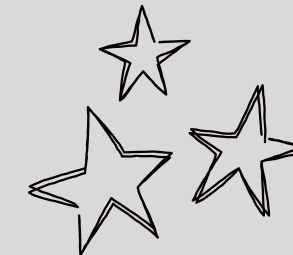
In Science, we will be continuing to explore electricity and how to create and manipulate electrical circuits. Children will suggest changes when circuits malfunction.
