

Experiences

Computing

In computing, the children will be learning how to touch type. The focus will be how to type with both hands, understanding how to sit at the keyboard and how to use home, top and bottom row keys.

English

Maths

In maths, we will be focusing on place value of numbers, securing and deepening our knowledge of hundreds, tens and ones. We will be using our known facts up to 10 to help us work out equations up to 100 and then we will be learning to add and take away over 100 too.



Design and Technology

This half term, children will be creating a sculpture of a dragons eye out of clay! They will be practising different designs and planning their eye in detail, before then making their 3D sculpture!




Geography
