In R.E we will be studying Rites of Passage and how these important events shape our lives. Furthermore, we will link this with the Islamic religion and key events within this faith.

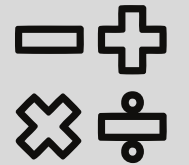


96 Curriculum Overview

Autumn 1
