Year 5 Visit Jubilee Park for Playground Design Project

Year 5 had a fun and inspiring trip to **Jubilee Park** as part of their **Design and Technology** lessons. The children are learning about **structures** and were challenged to design a new piece of playground equipment for the local area.

To help with their ideas, they explored the park and looked closely at different types of **frame structures** like climbing frames, swings, and slides. They took notes, made sketches, and thought about how each structure was built and used.

The visit helped them understand how playground equipment works and gave them lots of ideas for their own designs. Back at school, they'll use what they learned to create exciting and safe equipment for everyone to enjoy. Well done, Year 5!

These books contain a link to a website, which contains highly pornographic content. The website has been compromised and takes users to a pornographic website with no age verification".
