

Music

Computing

This half term, the children will be learning about caring and respectful relationships. They will be discussing who to trust and will explore stereotypes in society and how this can be negative.

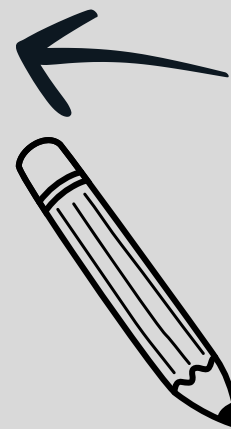


Year 6 Curriculum Overview Autumn 2



Religious Education

In R.E we will be studying the concept of community within the Christian religion. We will be comparing and contrasting Mathew & Luke's Christmas birth story and discussing which one the children prefer and why.



DT

In DT, we will be baking a war time 'sweet treat'. This will be in the form of carrot cake. Children will explore the basic ingredients used as well as practising their grating, cutting and weighing skills.



History

We will be learning about World War 2 - when and why it began and its impact on our local area. We will consider rationing, evacuation and what made Portsmouth vulnerable to potential attacks.



Science

In Science, we will be continuing our learning around sound. The children will be conducting various experiments about how sound travels and how sound can be insulated.



French

This half term, the children will be looking at Healthy Lifestyles. The children will be able to say what they should eat and drink to stay healthy.



Maths

In maths, children will be continuing their exploration of fractions, percentages and decimals. Children will also move onto a new unit looking at geometry and time. Arithmetic focus will be based on targeted assessment.
