There is limited space in the rooms/pods, so please keep clothes and baggage to a minimum. Squashy bags are a good idea.

Essential Items

- Sleeping Bag
- Bottom Sheet
- Pillow and Pillow case
- Towel
- Wash kit
- Water bottle
- Torch and spare batteries
- Plastic bags for laundry and wet clothes
- Pyjamas
- Warm jumper or fleece and a hat and gloves - even in the summer it can be cool in the evenings
- Waterproof jacket and trousers
- Change of clothes for each day
- Slippers, or clean indoor shoes
- Sun block and sun hat
- Medication (where appropriate given to your Group Leader)

Other items

- Wellies – it can get muddy on the camping field and in the activities area (not to be used on any watersports)
- Camera – a disposable one is a good idea.

I suspect the sun cream and sun hat might need to be substituted with a scarf, hat and gloves instead!

On Monday 26th January we are due to depart at 9.00am. Children should come to school at the normal time of 8.30am, latest 8.45am in time for departure. **All children must bring a packed lunch for Monday** and meet Miss Jones at the school hall with their bags.

All medication must be given to Miss Jones on arrival at school. Please ensure medication is labelled with clear instructions for administration.

On our return, we are due to arrive back at 3.15pm. However, we will communicate any timing updates on this day via text message should we be delayed for any reason – or early! All children should be collected by an adult.
