

## Experiences

The children will be visiting the Portsmouth Guildhall to watch a performance by the Bournemouth Symphony orchestra, take part in a Roman workshop and explore Judaism with a Rabbi visit to school.



## Computing

In Computing, the children will be finding out what a simulation is and understanding what the purpose is. They will explore a simulation, make choices and discuss the effects.

## Spring 1



## Maths

In maths, the children will be learning how to explore right angles particularly in triangles and quadrilaterals. They will also focus on understanding and manipulating the additive relationship and securing mental calculation.



## D&T

This half term, children will be creating a Roman purse, linked to their History learning. They will learn sewing skills, as well as thinking about designing something inspired by the Roman times!



## History

The children will be learning about the Romans and what the Romans brought to England. We will be thinking about the pros and cons of the Romans invading and the legacy they have left behind.



## Science
