In P.E, the focus of this half term is Gymnastics. Children will be exploring different ways of travelling both individually and together around the room and at various heights.

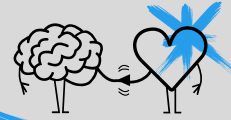
English

Maths

In maths, children will be focusing on calculation and securing their ability to calculate the four operations in addition to fractions, decimals and percentages.



Art

In Art, we will focus on the work of Bobbi Baugh who uses her own print designs to create collages. Children will create their print and collage in this artist's style.
