Dear Parents and Carers

Year 6 Visit to Paultons Park

This half term will be the children's last at Hart Plain Junior School. To celebrate their time here and reward them for all their hard work, we are proposing to take our Year 6 children to Paultons Park. We have therefore made a provisional booking for **Tuesday 21st July 2026**. The cost of the visit is **£28.00**.

As this is an end of year reward for both working hard and a positive attitude to learning, it has been decided that it will be at the discretion of the Year 6 teachers as to whether the behaviour of any individual warrants exclusion from the trip. We will be taking into consideration children's general attitude to learning, their ability to play cooperatively and respectfully at break time as well as any disruptions within the classroom environment. Support will be put in place to ensure that as many children as possible will join us on this trip.

Your child's class teacher will contact you directly should your child be at risk of not attending the trip. We would ask that you talk to your child about their behaviour and express how important it is that they work hard and finish their time at Hart Plain Junior School in a positive way.

Since this is a non-educational trip, and more than 50% of the visit will take place out of curriculum hours, this visit will incur a charge rather than a request for a voluntary contribution. **This means that we will need full payment, by Monday 13th July 2026, in order for your child to take part.**

All outstanding money owed to the school must also be cleared prior to the trip in order for your child to take part. Late payments **cannot** be accepted as we have to finalise ticket numbers by this date. Please make payment via the Arbor Parent Portal and complete the [online form](#) by Monday 13th July 2026 in order to give permission for your child to take part.

Children need to be in school by 8.30 am on the day and we aim to leave at 9.00 am, travelling by coach. The children will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink with them – enough to sustain them during the day! **Please note that if your child is entitled to a free school dinner, the school will provide a packed lunch for them that day if you complete the relevant part of the online form.**

The children do not have to wear school uniform; however, we ask that they come suitably dressed for a theme park with clothing appropriate to the weather conditions. No crop tops, no skirts and no high-rise cycle shorts (i.e. Nike Pros). Please make sure your child has sun cream on if it is a hot day and a hat if possible. The children will need to be wearing comfortable and appropriate footwear as it is a long day and they will be doing lots of walking – therefore, no crocs! Please ensure all footwear has closed toes and is securely held on the foot. Paultons Park is cashless and therefore children will not be able to bring money to spend on this day. **Children are not permitted to bring their mobile phones.**

We hope to arrive back at school by 5.30 pm and ask that you collect your child from the school hall. If we are running late for any reason, then we will send a message via Arbor. We hope that this will

be a fantastic day, celebrating all the achievements of the children in Year 6. If you have any queries regarding this trip, please do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher.
