School Uniform Ordering Update

We are pleased to share that we are introducing a new ordering system for school uniform through Brigade, with the option of **free delivery to school**. Orders placed via this service will be held in a queue and processed twice monthly (on the 15th and 30th). Delivery to school will take place within up to 14 days after these dates.

As we approach the end of term, **home delivery will also be available**. This option will remain in place until **11th September**. The **HSCP [Water Safety Toolkit](#)** for parents and carers offers simple, practical advice to help families stay safe, including:

- **Everyday risks at home** – including bath time safety and garden hazards
- **Staying safe outdoors** – such as the beach, around rivers and in open water
- **Practical safety advice** – including the Water Safety Code and how to “Float to Live”
- **Age-specific guidance** – for babies, young children, older children and teenagers
- **What to do in an emergency** – including simple first aid steps and where to find further support

Small actions - like close supervision, choosing safe places to swim and talking regularly with children - can make a big difference.

Holiday Activities & Food (HAF) Programme – Summer 2026

We are pleased to share information about the **Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) Programme**, available this summer for children and young people who are eligible for benefit-related free school meals.

This programme is a really important source of support for families during the summer holidays, offering **free childcare, fun activities and nutritious meals**. This year, over **200 HAF schemes** will be running across Hampshire.

What's new this year?

Bookings opened on **22 June**, and there is now a **new central booking system**, making it much easier to:

- Find local holiday clubs
- Book places
- Join waiting lists if sessions are full

The system also includes **built-in eligibility checks**, so there is no longer a need to use previously issued HAF codes. New activities are being added regularly, so it's worth checking back if you don't find something straight away.
